PRESCHOOL PROGRAM- TNA TINIES

Introduce your toddler to the joy of dance through our Preschool Program! We combine the magic of movement of ballet, tap and modern, with the latest research in childhood development for an unforgettable dance experience. Our classes are thoughtfully designed to inspire creativity, boost self-confidence, and instill a lifelong passion for dance, all within a nurturing and fun setting!

TRAINEE

Trainee is our training-only program for students who want to excel in both technique and artistry without performance commitments. This program welcomes dancers ages 3 to 18 of all skill levels—from beginners taking their very first dance steps to experienced dancers ready to refine their technique. This program is for anyone who seeks the best in dance education. Dancers can enroll in classes that fit their schedule and training needs (no audition required). Trainee requires no commitments beyond weekly classes, making it the perfect supplemental training program for dancers focused on honing their technique, improving skills, making new friends, and having lots of fun .

FUSION

Fusion is our part-time competition team for students ages 4 to 18 eager to be apart of a team, participate in competitions and performances, and grow as performers. Fusion students train on Saturdays 9:00am-5:30pm.

Each week includes a dedicated rehearsal class for practicing competitive group dances, ensuring our dancers are performance-ready and technique-strong. Fusion participates in local and international competitions, and 1 local performance each year, providing ample opportunities for dancers to showcase their talents, and fuel their love for dance on stage!

CORE

The Core offers a rigorous, full-time training program for serious dancers ages 5 to 18 interested in pursuing careers in performing arts or becoming champions. Our students learn all subjects required to break into the industry, where every dancer is challenged to push their limits and explore their full potential.

Dancers aged five and older, demonstrating maturity, discipline, and a strong work ethic, are invited to join this pathway. Students on The Core take 12 hours of mandatory classes and rehearsals per week, diversifying their training and guiding them to become well-rounded artists. The Core attends 2 conventions, 2 local competition, and are invited to national/international competitions. Students are always encouraged to attend extra conventions if they do not conflict with weekend classes or rehearsals.

HOME SCHOOL

Students who are home schooled, are allowed to request zoom or in person classes, during weekday day time.

STYLES OFFERED

ACROBATICS

Students will gradually build the strength, flexibility, control, and endurance needed to execute tricks safely and with exceptional technique. From limbering to tumbling to balancing to trending tricks, our students leave each class feeling confident and eager to learn more!

BALLET

Ballet is the foundation of all dance, achieved through barre and center floor work, with a focused attention to proper alignment, technique, and artistry. Students are classically trained with an emphasis on challenging each dancer to the highest degree of technical and artistic excellence-appropriate for their ability level.

JAZZ- CORNER/ COMBO

This class blends various dance styles, giving young dancers a well-rounded introduction to multiple genres and teaching them to memorise choreography with precision, style, and dynamics.

TAP

This class gives dancers a well-rounded understanding to musicality, style, dynamics, and rhythm.

LYRICAL AND CONTEMPORARY

Lyrical encourages dancers to explore movement through grounded techniques and abstract concepts. Built off from a balletic foundation, It often involves contractions, spirals, and floor work, promoting a strong sense of body awareness and emotional expression.

PRE POINTE/ POINTE

Pointe class is a demanding ballet technique that requires dancers to dance on the tips of their toes, supported by pointe shoes. Approval from the faculty is necessary prior to enrollment.

CONDITIONING/ STRETCH

Stretch & Strength is designed to prevent injuries while improving your dancer's technical foundation through a combination of static/dynamic stretching and full-body strengthening. Students will learn how to use correct muscle groups while achieving a full range of motion to execute movement safely and properly.

TECHNIQUE- TURNS & LEAPS

Turns & Leaps class concentrates on skill-building through proper placement, alignment, and strength. We provide detail instructors for teaching current and new skills, helping students understand not just the 'how' but the why of correct technique in turns, leaps, and tricks.

DRAMA/ SINGING/ MUSICAL THEATRE

Students who are improving their dance skills, your performer will learn how to use dance, song and script to express themselves and tell a story. They will learn how to convey emotion and enhance their performances. This will help them develop their creativity and artistry, which are essential skills for any performer.

COMMERCIAL/ STREET DANCE

Street and commercial dance is essential for building coordination and performance skills! It improves our pupils' confidence, musicality, and their ability to pick up new styles and routines whilst also allowing their personality to really shine. It's the style that is most often seen at pop concerts and in music videos, and is a lot of fun learning to express yourself in class and on stage in our big shows!

Street/commercial is danced to current and recent chart music and covers a wide range of musical styles. We always make sure that our routines and music choices are age-appropriate and suitable for the level.

PRIVATE LESSONS

Competition Privates:

Private Lessons are exclusively sent to children by invitation to learn a new solo, duet, or trio at the discretion of Miss Tia. These specialised sessions run for a minimum of one month depending on how quickly the student learns, dedicated to refining and perfecting the dance routines. Subsequently, students are required to practice and review their routines at home.

Moreover, solos, duets, and trios will be rehearsed during the group competition classes scheduled on Wednesday's. This structure enables us to monitor dance progress without incurring additional expenses for parents. Children not in attendance on a Wednesday will not be invited in for these private lessons.

Parents are required to confirm their acceptance or decline of this opportunity. Regrettably, the time slots for private lessons are non-negotiable once the original invitation is issued. Declining a private slot may impact the likelihood of future opportunities being sent.

LAMDA Private Lessons & Exams

At the Tia Noakes Academy, we are proud to offer LAMDA (London Academy of Music & Dramatic Art) private lessons to support and develop our students' performance skills beyond the dance studio. These one-to-one or small group sessions focus on Speech and Drama, Acting, Verse and Prose, and Public Speaking, depending on each student's goals and interests.

LAMDA lessons provide a structured and inspiring way for young performers to grow in confidence, clarity of speech, expression, and stage presence. Whether your child is aiming to pursue a career in the performing arts or simply wishes to build self-assurance and communication skills, LAMDA training offers a valuable and rewarding experience.

Students can work towards internationally recognised graded examinations, which not only celebrate their progress but also contribute to UCAS points at the higher levels – a fantastic benefit for older students preparing for university applications.

LAMDA lessons can help students:

- Develop vocal confidence and clear speech
- Improve acting and storytelling techniques
- Build emotional intelligence and stage presence
- Gain confidence in public speaking and interviews
- Achieve recognised qualifications and milestones

Our LAMDA teacher tailors each lesson to the individual, ensuring students are supported, challenged, and creatively inspired. These sessions are available as weekly private lessons, and spaces are limited. Please contact us for current availability and pricing. These sessions run all year round.

Dance Technique Private Lessons

We offer Focus-Based Dance Technique Private Lessons to provide personalised support and training for students looking to refine specific areas of their dance practice. These one-to-one sessions are ideal for dancers who wish to build strength, improve flexibility, enhance technique, or develop precision in their overall dance performance.

Each lesson is carefully tailored to the student's individual needs, whether that's mastering a skill, building turnout strength, or deepening technical understanding in a particular discipline. This is a fantastic opportunity to accelerate progress with dedicated attention.

These private lessons are especially beneficial for students who want a little extra push to reach their full potential. Sessions are booked as part of a termly plan. Availability is limited, and times are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Please contact us for more information on booking and pricing.

FEE STRUCTURE

Payments

Full payment must be received in advance to confirm a place. For all current students, courses must be registered in advance. Payment can be made up until the first day of the new month, to guarantee the place. If payment for registered places is not received a 20% late payment fee is charged. If after 7 days, fee's have still been unpaid and TNA hasn't been contacted in advance, the place will be offered to another student using the priority listed above.

Holidays

To keep payments consistent for parents, we evenly spread the class fees over the course of 12 months or if starting mid academic year, we split over the remaining months leading up to August. Ensuring affordable and convenient monthly payments. No refunds are given for holidays, illnesses or any classes that are missed.

Non-payment

Failure to make payment before term starts may result in no place being available. If this happens Tia Noakes Academy will make every attempt to offer an alternative course or arrangement. If this is not possible then your name will be added to a waiting list. If payment is outstanding, Tia Noakes Academy reserves the right to withhold services. Every attempt will be made not to discuss monies owed with children, although in extreme circumstances (especially when children arrive without supervision) children may be turned away.

Tia Noakes Academy may share data with debt collection agencies in order to re-coup monies owed.

Cancellation

If you wish to leave TNA or make any changes to your Childs classes, a minimum of one month's notice should be given. Customers must pay this last month's fees. Occasionally some classes may be cancelled due to circumstances beyond Tia Noakes Academy's control. The team will endeavour to contact paid customers and will either offer an exchange for the class or, in some cases of a cancellation made by TNA, a full refund will be given.

Tia Noakes Academy reserves the right to cancel a course if there are fewer than seven participants on a course and the above efforts will be made to place a student in an alternative course or offer a pro-rata refund where appropriate.

SCHOOL TERMS

PART 1

This is part of your agreement when joining Tia Noakes Academy. Membership is open to all subject to the following conditions:

- Tia Noakes Academy accepts no responsibility for loss or damage of personal belongings while on the premises.
- Tia Noakes Academy accepts no liability for any injuries sustained whilst participating in a class or on the premises.
- Tia Noakes Academy Staff must be notified of any changes to the information provided on the Booking Form.

Staff/teachers:

Staff, including cover teachers (who may be brought in at short notice), are experienced and DBS checked. Volunteer class assistants and trainees on placements are all DBS checked. There is always a first aider on site.

Behaviour:

Racist, sexist and other offensive language and behaviour is not tolerated, and we reserve the right to terminate membership without notice, the final decision being undertaken by the Principal, Miss Tia. Behaviour of staff, parents and students must always follow our code-of-conduct. Please note that under no circumstances are pets allowed on school premises due to Health and Safety reasons.

Shows:

Parents/carers may be invited to one class/performance per term. Parents/carers are not permitted to watch otherwise. TNA aim to host a full school annual show every two years, parents are always notified of this at least 8 months prior. TNA asks all parents/ carers to help fundraise to keep costs as low as possible to fund costumes for the students.

Emergency contact number:

Tia Noakes Academy emergency mobile phone is kept on during all TNA hours, unless another number has been issued to use if the main mobile is unavailable. The number will be given out upon registration and must only be used if there are problems regarding the collection of children. No spontaneous calls or texts should be made.

Uniform:
This is basic but essential and gives the students a sense of belonging, a sense of ritual and sense of dressing for something important – their class.

Appropriate clothing as below is necessary for health and safety and child protection:

Students must not wear their own clothing to any class – wearing the correct Tia Noakes Academy clothing gives a sense of belonging, allowing all to feel equal, healthy and safe.

- All t-shirts, shoes and bags must be clearly labelled – lost property is donated to charity at the end of every term.
- Strictly no jewellery – no earrings (earrings are very unsafe during physical activity).
- Hair must be slick back into ONE BUN for all classes.
- SECOND-HAND SHOES and CLOTHING for sale: there is often a good selection of second-hand clothing and shoes which can be bought from Tia Noakes Academy at a greatly reduced rate including tap and ballet shoes.

DONATIONS OF DANCE CLOTHING:

We welcome donations of dance wear that are in good condition and can be re-sold at a small price or lent to students. Please message for a uniform order form, a checklist is provided in your welcome pack!

Attendance:

Children must arrive and be collected promptly. It is very important that children arrive in time for their classes, preferably 5 minutes before the start. This allows the group time to settle from the moment the class starts. Latecomers will have to wait outside until an appropriate time to join the class. Children arriving after 15 minutes may be refused admission, as this may disrupt the professional attitude to classes we aim to foster.

The doors open 5 minutes prior up until the start time of class, after this they close to ensure smooth running of classes, we aim to finish 5 minutes before pick up times.

Late pick ups- if you are later than 15 minutes to pick up your dancer, a £10 fee is added to your next bill. Every minute after 15 minutes you are late picking up, £1 is added. It is in safeguarding procedure if no contact has been made in 45 minutes then the police will be contacted. Where possible Tia Noakes Academy will aim to let people know of any changes in venue or class time at least one week ahead of schedule.

Absence:

Any child missing for more than two classes per term without reason may not be able to join future events. Class numbers are limited, and many have waiting lists, so good attendance and commitment to the course is essential.

Illness/Injury:

Parents are not to allow their child to attend TNA if they are feeling unwell or have a known injury which would prevent a student from fully taking part. This includes presenting any contagious illness including (but not limited to): Chicken Pox, Head Lice, Common Cold, Flu.

PART 2

Child Collection:

TIA NOAKES ACADEMY TEACHER POLICY AND PROCEDURE FOR YOUR INFORMATION

Teachers must ensure that each child has left a session with an adult or older child (agreed in advance with parent). It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to ensure the child is collected punctually at the end of the class or session. Should a parent/guardian not turn up to collect a child on time – this is the procedure to follow:

- Inform Miss Tia who will contact the parent/guardian.
- If Miss Tia is not available, contact the parent/guardian directly to arrange collection.
- If the parent/carer is not reachable, and you must leave, the emergency procedure is as follows:
- Leave a message with the parent and contact Miss Tia or Miss Lauryn. Wait until another member of the team can arrive.
- If the parent/guardian is not reachable and there is no adult available, you must take the child to the nearest police station. Inform the police of all contact details for the parent/guardian and notify the entire Tia Noakes Academy Team

as above. Leave a message for the parent/guardian to say where the child will be.

Booking:

Tia Noakes Academy does not provide drop-in classes for children and young people on all term time courses. All courses must be booked in advance. New students may join courses during the term subject to availability and authorisation of the Tia Noakes Academy team. If there are no spaces on a requested course when booking, then TNA will aim to provide an alternative option where possible.

Waiting List:

Members on the waiting list will be contacted in order of the list. If members are unavailable, no message will be left. The next member will be contacted and the first to make contact will receive the place. Please refer to the booking policy.

Payments

Full payment must be received in advance to confirm a place. For all current students, courses must be registered in advance. Payment can be made up until the first day of the month, to guarantee the place. If payment for registered places is not received by this time and TNA hasn't been contacted in advance, then the place will be offered to another student using the priority listed above.

Holidays

We ask that parents book holidays steering clear from any events that are in the diary. If your dancer is apart of either our Fusion or Core track, they must be fully available for rehearsals prior to any event they commit to, any dancers who are not in attendance for rehearsals risk losing their space within a dance, or event.

REFUNDS:

Tia Noakes Academy cannot offer a refund if you do not attend courses. A full refund will be given if the chosen workshop date/ course is fully booked on receipt of payment.

NEW STUDENTS ONLY: The first class are considered 'trial' classes- if you have booked a trial online. Please note, no refund or reduction will be made after the second class has taken place, whether further classes have been attended or not.

Holiday courses are non-refundable.

Core Values

Safety and well-being are paramount, and we maintain a secure learning environment. We expect our students to show dedication and drive, maintain a positive attitude, respect their instructors and peers, and take responsibility for their training.

Parents are encouraged to support their child's passion for dance and commitment to their training, maintain open lines of communication with studio faculty to address any questions or concerns, and display a positive attitude towards the studio, instructors, and other parents and students. By adhering to these core values, we create a thriving, respectful, and motivating environment for everyone at Tia Noakes Academy. to excel and grow as performers and individuals.

Photo Release

By enrolling at Tia Noakes Academy , you grant permission for the studio to photograph and videotape your dancer during classes and studio events. These images and videos may be used for promotional purposes, including social media, the studio's website, and other marketing materials. If you do not consent to this, you must notify us in advance by emailing Office@Tianoakesacademy.com

General Policies

Dancers must arrive on time for class. If a dancer Is more than 15 minutes late, they may be asked to wait until the next class to ensure safe participation. Our top-priority is to foster a positive, supportive, and respectful learning environment; therefore, students must show respect for instructors and peers at all times. Talking during class is strictly prohibited except when necessary for class-related discussions. Disruptive behavior, such as using cell phones during class, not participating in training, or displaying a negative attitude, will not be tolerated and may result in temporary removal from class. The dress code is mandatory and must be followed at all times. Students should feel comfortable communicating with their instructor, if they have any concerns or questions related to their dance education or scheduling conflicts. We are always happy and available to communicate with you regarding any questions or concerns.
